The protection of your personal data is very important to us. We handle your data according to the european law General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR, TKG 2003 (Austrian law)). In this document we inform you about the most important aspects of our data processing.

### Contact with us

If you contact us per email we will save this contact information to handle your inquiry and save it for later possible requests. We don't give your information to others without your agreement.

### Web-Analysis

Our website uses the functionality of the web-analysis-tool "Google Analytics" by Google LLC (GDPR-conform). Therefore, we use cookies to analyse your use of our website. The information gathered by this cookies will be sent to the servers of this provider and will be stored there. To prohibit this action, you can change your browser-settings so that it prevents websites from storing cookies.

We have made a contract with this provider for commissioned data processing. The relation to this provider is based on standard contract agreements. The data processing is based on the law according to § 96 Abs 3 TKG as well as Art 6 Abs 1 lit a (agreement) or (legitimate interest) of the GDPR.

Our wish according to the GDPR is the improvement of our website. We care about the data of our users, therefore all user-data is pseudonymous data. User-data will be stored for 14 months.
